FIRE IN OIL TANKER

Petrol pump dealers assn blames failure of static earthing

Petrol pump dealers association has said that failure of static earthing caused fire, which broke out in an oil tanker at Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited oil filling depot at Bhauri Bakania under Khajuri Sadak police station area on Friday. The mishap left seven people injured.



Static earthing is important in processes dealing with volatile products, where a single spark can lead to disastrous consequences. Association president Ajay Singh said, "There must be proper static earthing at time of refilling oil tankers at depots. If it fails, it may lead to fire. It might be reason behind this tragedy."

As per the petrol pump dealers association, around 12,000 litres of fuel is filled in the tanker.

There are three compartments inside the tanker and each has capacity of 4,000 litres. At the time of the accident, one compartment of the tanker was filled with petrol, while the other was being filled with diesel. The blast took place in the third compartment. Investigation into the incident has begun.

Chirayaj Hospital director Dr Ajay Goenka said, "Four out of seven injured persons are critical. Three of them are on ventilator. Doctors are monitoring the situation round the clock."

REGULATIONS

Under Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Act, the Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board has made following regulations.

Earthing design should be in accordance with the requirements of Central Electricity Authority Regulations or equivalent system recognised by statutory authorities under Petroleum Act / Electricity Act. All earth connections should be visible for inspection. The earthing system shall have an earthing network with required number of earth electrodes connected to it.

Bus brakes, gear box hit by snag: Rewa accident survivor

After having food from dhaba, the bus's gear box was not working properly. On the slope, it lost control and the mishap took place. This is what one of the passengers stated while talking to media after the accident.



He was one of the passengers who was travelling in the sleeper bus that rammmed into a trailer-truck from behind in Rewa district on late Friday night that left 15 people dead and 40 injured. Officials informed that the labourers had decided to take a bus to reach their houses on the Dipawali festival.

All of them were happy and had purchased items for the family like sari, clothes for children and many other decorative items for display in their houses. But for many, this Dipawali brought misery because of accident.

The survivor further added that few of the passengers asked the driver to check the problem properly before starting. But he did not do so. Although Choudhary survived, he suffered injuries on his hand and legs. He was going to his hometown (Maharajganj) in Uttar Pradesh from Hyderabad to celebrate Diwali with his loved ones. But the accident shattered his dream as he is now undergoing treatment in a hospital in Rewa.

"I was fast asleep and celebrating Diwali in my dream. I had gone to sleep after having dinner with fellow passengers. But I woke up to a loud thud. In a second or two, cries like 'God save me, God help me' resounded in our bus," he said.

"My dream soon turned into a nightmare and I literally felt stars were tumbling around me. I was writing in pain and there were several others like me. I saw helpless people in pools of blood inside the bus. Some of them were not responding, while some others were gasping for breath," he added.
