Combating Naxals: Out-of-turn...

Our government is giving out-of-turn promotion to the jivans who put their lives at stake in the Naxal eradication campaign," said Chouhan. Speaking on the occasion, minister Mishra said Balghat district is affected by Naxalite activity, adding that police have so far killed or arrested ultras carrying a cumulative reward of 93 lakh on their heads. He asked members of the outbowed movement to end violence and join the mainstream. "If we know how to fight, we also know how to follow the Buddha's path of peace," said Mishra. Balghat Superintendent of Police Sameer Saurabh said the state police's elite Hawk Force had gunned down three hardcore Naxalites, with a cumulative bounty of Rs 57 lakh on their heads, on June 20 this year. "The 31 jivans involved in this encounter are being given out-of-turn promotions," the SP informed.

Truss beats Sunak...

In her brief address on the occasion, Truss thanked the party for 'organising one of the longest job interviews in history', as well as her supporters. She praised her rivals, particularly Sunak, saying that the campaign was 'hard-fought' and showed 'the death and breadth of talent' in the party. Truss pledged to follow through on her promises to voters, saying the Tory party needs to show it can deliver over the next two years, and that she has a 'bold plan' to cut taxes and grow the UK economy. On the rising energy bills, she says she will 'deliver' when it comes to crisis but not only dealing with bills but also the long term supply issues.

IndiGo flight returns...

Passengers were told that some noise was coming from the engine, so the crew diverted the plane back to Agra for safety. Initially, the passengers were asked to wait for some time, some passengers cancelled the journey by taking refund and some passengers agreed to go to Mumbai by IndiGo's evening flight.

Four dead, 10...

The deceased have been identified as Gurnoor Singh Anand (88), a resident of Naka Hindola (Lucknow), Sahiba Kaur alias Jaspreet (26), a resident of Ganeshtanj (Lucknow), Shrivika Sant (18), a resident of Indiranagar (Lucknow) and Ammar Ghazi (22), a resident of Khurrannagar (Lucknow)," he said.

Ujjawal, who was staying on the second floor of the hotel, said fire broke out at around 7 am and he saw smoke in his room. "When I came out, I along with others tried to go out, but thick smoke engulfed the entire floor. I could not see anything due to the smoke. Then we reached the third floor and broke a window to come out and were rescued," he said. Another guest on the same floor said there were no fire fighting arrangements in the hotel due to which they got trapped. Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath visited the injured in the hospital and enquired about their health. He also ordered a joint probe by the commissioner, Lucknow division, and police commissioner of Lucknow into the incident. He directed officials to provide free and appropriate treatment to the injured. Police Commissioner of Lucknow S B Shrivastava said the forensic audit of the hotel building will be done. The fire, which led to panic in the area, engulfed the entire hotel within minutes, eyewitnesses said. Crowds gathered as evacuation efforts got underway. Fire teams had a tough time dousing the flames after breaking glass panes.

Lingayat seer commits...

The audio clip containing an alleged conversation between the two women discussing how women and girls were exploited at Chitravada must viral on social media. The two women bring up the name of deceased Basava Siddaling Swamiji in the discussion which has cast aspersions on his reputation and honour, explained police sources. The seer, who ended his life, was painted with the development, and devotees of the mutt had lodged a complaint with DySP of Bylahongala in Belagavi district seeking action against vested interests who are targeting Lingayat pontiffs.

Soreen govt wins confidence vote amid walkout by BJP

RANCHI: The Hemant Soren government in Jharkhand on Monday won the confidence vote in the Assembly by a comfortable margin, helping the politically-savvy tribal leader consolidate his hold over the state despite fears that his MLAs would be poached to bring down the JMM-led regime. As many as 88 MLAs voted in favour of the confidence motion in the 81-member Assembly. 29 of the JMM, 15 of the Congress, one each of RJD, NCP and CPIM(L) and an Independent - even as the opposition BJP-led NDA walked out of the House.

Speaking during the special session, Soren said the need for the trust vote was felt as the BJP was 'attempting to destabilise democratically elected governments' in non-BJP ruled states, including Jharkhand. "Uncertainty had been prevalent in the state since August 25 after the media re-

ported that the ECI has sent its recommendation to governor. But the governor is still silent. An UPA delegation met him urging him to clear the air. He assured them that there will be clarity in two-three days. Thereafter, he went to Delhi through the backdoor," the CM claimed. Soren, who still faces the threat of disqualification on the basis of the purported EC advisory to the Governor, had ring-fenced his MLAs by flying them down to neighbouring Congress-ruled Chhattisgarh. The worried leader, however, decided to face up to his challenges as the uncertainty over the crisis prolonged, by coming up with the vote of confidence proposal and flying in his legislators Sunday night.

Sisodia says CBI officer ended life due to pressure to frame him

DELHI: Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia on Monday alleged that a CBI officer ended his life because of pressure to frame him in a false excise case and demanded an "independent judicial" probe into the death. The federal agency dismissed the charge as 'mischievous and misleading'. Sisodia's accusation came as he faced a fresh salvo from the BJP on the excise policy row, with the party releasing a "sting operation" video that purportedly showed the father of a liquor scam accused claiming to have paid "commission" to acquire liquor licences in Delhi. Sisodia, however, called the video a "joke". In a statement, the CM said his officer Jitendra Kumar was in "no way connected" with the probe related to the excise policy case and Sisodia's statements were an attempt to divert attention from the

Raut's JC extended by 14 days

A special court here on Monday extended Shiv Sona MP Sanjay Raut's judicial custody by another 14 days in a money laundering case linked to alleged irregularities in the redevelopment of a Mumbai building. Raut, 60, was arrested by the ED on August 1 under the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA) in connection with alleged financial irregularities in the redevelopment of the Patra Chawl (row tenement) in suburban Goregaon. He was produced before special PMLA judge MG Deshpande at the end of his judicial remand on Monday.

'BJP's sting Op on liquor scam a joke'

NEW DELHI: Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia on Monday termed the BJP's "sting operation" on the alleged Delhi excise policy scam a "joke" while reiterating his claim the CBI has given him a "clean chit" in the matter. Stepping up its attack on the AAP, the BJP released a "sting operation" video on Monday that purportedly showed the father of an excise scam accused claiming to have paid commission to acquire liquor licences in Delhi. The agency also made it clear that "no clean chit" has been given to any of the accused in the Delhi excise policy case. AAP leaders have been repeatedly stating that Sisodia had been given a "clean chit" by the CBI officers investigating the alleged irregularities in the liquor policy.
